ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME I WAS DISPATCHED TO GATEWAY MIDSTATE TRUCK PLAZA IN REFERENCE TO A SUBJECT THAT HAD PARKED HIS CAR IN THE TRUCK PARKING LOT AND FLED ON FOOT FROM SECURITY.

UPON ARRIVAL I SPOKE WITH SECURITY OFFICER LAYTON WHO GAVE THIS ACCOUNT: LAYTON WAS MAKING HIS ROUNDS AND OBSERVED A CAR DRIVE INTO THE TRUCK TRACTOR PARKING LOT.

LAYTON ACTIVATED HIS EMERGENCY LIGHTS ON HIS MARKED SECURITY VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE WHITE IN COLOR DODGE INTREPID. (WHICH BEARED ILLINOIS REGISTRATION IH1273)

LAYTON STOPPED THE DODGE AFTER THE DRIVER PULLED IT INTO THE GRASSY AREA NEAR THE HIGHWAY AT THE SOUTH END OF THE PARKING LOT.

LAYTON ASKED IF THE OPERATOR WAS A TRUCK DRIVER WITH HIM STATING "NO".

THE SUBJECT, NOW IDENTIFIED AS HECHENBERGER, WAS SITTING IN HIS CAR WITH NO SHIRT ON AND STATED HE WAS LOOKING FOR INTERSTATE 55/70.

LAYTON TOLD HECHENBERGER HOW TO GET BACK TO THE HIGHWAY AND TOLD HIM NOT TO RETURN TO THE TRUCK STOP PARKING LOT, AND ESCORTED HIM OUT.

A FEW MINUTES LATER HECHENBERGER RETURNED ON THE LOT AND LAYTON TOLD ME HE FOLLOWED HIM BACK IN.

LAYTON FOUND HECHENBERGER'S PARKED CAR UNOCCUPIED AND SEARCHED THE LOT FOR HIM.

I SPOKE WITH A TRUCK DRIVER WHO WISHED TO REMAIN ANNONOMOUS WHO TOLD ME HE OBSERVED A LARGE W/M WALKING BETWEEN THE TRUCKS HOLDING HIS PANTS IN HIS HAND AND HAD NO SHIRT ON.

SGT. HUTCHINGS AND I SEARCHED THE TRUCK STOP PARKING LOT AND RETURNED TO HECHENBERGERS' CAR FINDING HIM STANDING NEXT TO IT.

SGT. HUTCHINGS AND I ASKED HECHENBERGER WHAT HE WAS DOING ON THE LOT WITH HIM TELLING US HE HAD TO GO TO THE BATHROOM.

SGT. HUTCHINGS ARRESTED HECHENBERGER WITHOUT INCIDENT AND CONVEYED HIM TO HEADQUARTERS WHERE HE WAS BOOKED AND RELEASED ON A CITY CHARGE FOR TRESPASS.
